How Do You Apply?

Apply online or through mail. To apply online, please go to: www.nyc.gov/housingconnect. To request an application by mail, send a postcard or self-addressed envelope, to: Atlantic Commons Phase II c/o Shinda Management Corp, 221-10 Jamaica Avenue, 3rd Floor, Queens Village NY 11428. Only send one application per development. Don't submit duplicate applications. Do not apply online and also send in a paper application. Applicants who submit more than one application may be disqualified.

When is the Deadline?

Applications must be postmarked or submitted online no later than **May 27, 2015.** Late applications will not be considered.

What Happens After You Submit an Application?

After the deadline, applications are selected for review through a lottery process. If your application is selected and you appear to qualify, You will be invited to an interview to continue the process of determining your eligibility. Interviews are usually scheduled from 2 to 10 months after the application deadline. You will be asked to bring documents that verify your household size, identity of members of your household, and your household income.







^{**} Household size includes everyone who will live with you, including parents and children. Units are subject to occupancy criteria.

^{***} Household earnings include salary, hourly wages, tips, Social Security, child support, and other income for household members. Income guidelines are subject to change.
