How Do You Apply?

Apply online or through mail. To apply online, please go to: www.nyc.gov/housingconne To request an application by mail, mail a self-addressed envelope to: Harlem West 117th Street, PO Box 2015, New York, NY 10035. Please do not submit duplicate applications. Applicants who submit more than one application will be disqualified. Choose only one method of applying; either by mail or online (not both, this would be considered duplicate applications).

When Is the Deadline?

Applications must be postmarked or submitted online no later than May 5, 2014 Late applications will not be considered.

What Happens After You **Submit an Application**

After the deadline, applications are selected for review through a lottery process. If your application is selected and you appear to qualify, you will be invited to an interview where management will continue the process of determining your eligibility. Interviews are usually scenduled from 2 to 10 months after the application deadline. You will be asked to bring documents that verify your household size, identity of members of your household, and your household income.
